



Walking in Massachusetts

Chapel Brook, Ashfield

Special tips for this location: Parking on Williamsburg Road, Ashfield, MA. Free parking on both sides of the road, look for the Trustees sign.

Grab your map and hike ½ mile up Pony Mountain to the summit. After the summit there are two out and back trail options: 1. Follow your footsteps back from the summit and look for the DAR Trail on the right before you reach the road – Take this route in the woods until you want to turn back! 2. Cross the street after the summit and take the Two Bridges Trail (literally you cross over 2 small bridges) after the second bridge you can turn back or continue on the other trails. Turn back to return to your car when you are finished.

Leashed dogs allowed. Lace up your hiking boots (it may be muddy), grab mosquito and tick spray, bring a snack and water bottle – ENJOY!
