How to determine if the call is a true emergency  
Lights, sirens- proper usage- due regard

Pre-trip inspection, traction, friction, braking systems, intersections, braking, backing, night driving, vision, environmental conditions.

The practical driver portion of the course will cover straight line driving and backing, alley docking, serpentine, lane change, diminishing clearance, confined space turn around, parallel parking, backing with and without a spotter and trailer handling.
