A.L.I.C.E. (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) is a set of proactive, options-based strategies, that increase your chances of survival during a violent intruder or Active Shooter event. For 14 years, the A.L.I.C.E. Training Institute has provided violent intruder response training to individuals and organizations across the nation.

This one-day course is designed to teach law enforcement as well as municipal/school personnel, skills and strategies, that bridge the gap between the time a violent event begins and law enforcement arrives.

Training Detail

- Background: You will become knowledgeable in statistics and information about active shooter situations and why A.L.I.C.E. training is effective.
- A.L.I.C.E. Concepts: We will deliver a detailed overview of A.L.I.C.E. training and the liability of proactive vs. passive response strategies.
- Physical Drills: You will experience live scenario drills that compare passive vs. active responses.

Who should attend: Law Enforcement and Municipal and School personnel who wish to become more familiar with the A.L.I.C.E concept.
