#### **Chainsaw Safety & Cutting Techniques**

This course is designed to educate personnel w ho use a chainsaw about safety, maintenance, use and handling. Participants w ill gain an understanding in w hat contributes to accidents and how to avoid them. Hands on and practical w ork planning strategies, including bucking and limbing, understanding compression and tension and dealing w ith spring poles w ill be coached and practiced in this course. Notching and back cutting w ill be introduced for small tree felling (trees of approximately six inches in diameter at chest height - 6" dbh).

There is a strong focus on personal safety, risk assessment and accident prevention. Training w orkers and developing skills that reduce variables and mitigate risks associated w ith chainsaw s and cutting techniques is the general theme of this course. This course complies w ith OSHA 1910.266, and ANSI Z133 standards for safe chainsaw use.

#### **Chipper Safety & Operations**

This course is designed to train workers to understand how to safety operate a brush chipper and the very important role they play in overall job site safety and accident prevention. A strong focus on risk management, safety and ergonomic work practices is demonstrated and practiced in this course. Topics addressed include: Integrated Risk Management, Emergency Readiness, & PPE, Communications,
