The Virus - What do we know now after 8 months of research?

- What is the viability of the virus in the built environment?

- Can they provide safer alternatives (reference a few established lists of safer products based on EPA's List N for COVID-19)?
- Proper PPE
- Preparing to get in your vehicle and go home
