Requirements

You must provide your own police cruiser for this training. If trainee is in an unmarked vehicle, they must be in uniform. Valid Police ID must be presented for ALL officers. Only registered attendees will be permitted into the course. Program will be conducted rain or shine however, in the event of measurable snowfall, the training will be rescheduled.

Registration Process

You will receive an automatic email acknowledgement through the system. Once this information is received you will be sent a formal email confirmation of your registration for training.
