This training will provide an overview of the related laws and regulations governing hoisting operations in Massachusetts. Discuss the importance of the operator's manual and knowing the risks associated with construction.

Operators may operate

All equipment having telescoping boom and wire rope and all equipment listed in class 1C, Equipment with hydraulic telescoping booms and any other hydraulic equipment designed for the purpose of hoisting, excluding those with wire rope hoist lines and all equipment listed in class 1D, General industrial warehouse Fork Lift equipment primarily used in indoor facilities.

**This course fulfills the 4 hour requirement by the State of Massachusetts, Department of Public Safety, for the continuing education required to renew the 1B Hoisting License.**
