Course Synopsis

The inclusion of skills was developed after examining insurance and police data to find the most dangerous activities and assessing the biggest needs. All training is performed in our vehicles, and each hands-on drill is taught in the car one-on-one with one of In Control's highly qualified instructors.

Hands-on training includes:

- Proper hands and seating
- Emergency braking skills (ABS)
- Backing up skills and awareness
- Advanced steering skills, including over, understeering & speed control
- Following distance/tailgating
- Anti-cell / text messaging/distraction experience
- Emergency avoidance measures

Classroom experience includes:

- Situational awareness and driving distractions (including cell/texting) Airbag awareness
