OSHA Outreach Trainer Requirements

Step 1- Successfully complete the OSHA Standards course for the desired discipline (Construction OSHA #510, General Industry OSHA #511, Maritime OSHA #5410 – OSHA Standards courses must be taken within seven years of the associated outreach trainer courses).

Step 2- Document 5 years* occupational (workplace) safety activities demonstrating knowledge and use of OSHA standards

Step 3- Register online with the following uploads:

- copy of transcripts if applicable
- Prerequisite Verification Form
- copy of certificate of completion from applicable OSHA standards course.

Step 4- OSHA Outreach Trainer Course: Valid Government ID must be presented at class. Successfully complete the OSHA Trainer Course in Occupational Safety and Health Standards for the desired discipline (Construction OSHA #500, General Industry OSHA #501, Maritime OSHA #5400).
