IMPORTANT PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

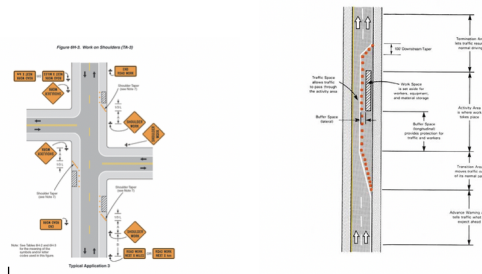
Due to limited parking, participants are asked to please carpool if at all possible. Parking is in the lower parking lot of the Town Hall parking lot. There is additional overflow parking behind the Fire Station 1 across the street at 5 Concord Road.

Presented by MIIA for municipal workers and police officers that work on or near roadways. The course focuses on the MA Highway work zone safety guidelines for temporary traffic control. In addition, the course will address the safe and effective use of law enforcement personnel in highway work zones.

Students will participate in small group activities, problem solving and information sharing. Students will have the opportunity to view and use personal protective equipment including high visibility clothing required when working on federal aid roadways.

Photographs and diagrams of work zones, fatality reports, construction activities that are often conducted in work zones and statistics will be reviewed and incorporated into activities. Resources and links to the MA Department of Labor Standards will be included in course materials.
