General Information

- MIIA will accept submissions for "Rewards-eligible Member Activities" until May 1, 2027 and "Member Directed Training" until May 20, 2027, or until the program's \$2.4 million budget is reached.
- Please submit Rewards information after completion of the relevant training or program to ensure our records are current.
- Training mandated by state and federal regulations is not eligible for Rewards credits, with the exception of specified OSHA workers compensation training.
- All activities and training should be sent to miiarewards@mma.org and risk manager with supporting information to include: title, agenda, presenter, length of training and audience (attendees). (Please note that attendance records for MIIA-sponsored training do not need to be submitted.)

Activities

- This year, the Risk Managers will discuss property and general liability programs to establish FY27 Rewards in these areas. We suggest that these conversations take place in the fall.

Training

- MIIA will track training credits for programs offered throughout the year.

MIIA Risk Managers can answer questions you may have and help you strategically select Rewards opportunities that best address your needs. The FY27 Rewards Program covers activities taking place between May 21, 2026 and the deadline of May 20, 2027.

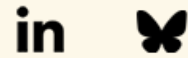
