Welcome to the FY22 Rewards Program. Based on your feedback and analysis of key program loss data, we have developed this year's reward opportunities to address common loss priorities and provide members with tools and training that promote a pro-active risk management approach.

Once again, the budget for FY22 Rewards has been level funded at 2.4 million dollars. As we all deal with the impact from COVID-19, we anticipate expanded Rewards participation and demand for services from members throughout the state. We will continue to offer a wide range of virtual trainings which will be augmented by onsite training as the COVID landscape changes. In some areas there is a pent-up demand for onsite training. We are beginning to schedule training to meet this demand.

The FY22 Rewards will cover activity from 5/23/21 to the submittal deadline of 5/20/22. Due to invoice processing requirements no exceptions can be made to this deadline.
