Special tips for this location: Mass Audubon members are free, non-members are \$6.00/adult and \$4.00/children and seniors, check out the beautiful boardwalks, sunning turtles during season, beautiful waterfalls, and walk ideas on their website including the All Persons Trail, Charles River loop and Glacial Hill Trail.

Parking is easy and tucked off the road at 280 Eliot Street, Natick, Ma. Trails are mostly flat. Wear your sneakers if it's dry or your hiking boots if it's a wet season. Get helpful advice by a Mass Audubon employee and use the restroom at the visitor center Tue–Sun, 9 am-5 pm-Closed Mon (except holidays)! Please leave your pets at home.
