

# Walking in Massachusetts



## White Cedar Swamp Trail Wellfleet, MA

### Special tips for this location:

- Parking for the White Cedar Swamp Trail is free at the Marconi Station Site, located at 195 Marconi Station Road. Please note that if you plan to visit Marconi Beach as well, there is a separate entrance fee.
- Seasonal restrooms are available at the location.
- Keep an eye out for the brown signs directing you to the Marconi Site and the White Cedar Swamp Trail.

**Highlights:** This 1.2-mile loop walk offers a diverse range of ecosystems. You'll begin in a lovely oak and pine forest, then continue onto a boardwalk that winds through the swamp, and finally return to the parking area via the historic "wireless road," a soft sand path.

If you have some extra time, you might consider adding a visit to Marconi Beach (for a fee) to your outing!

Dogs are not permitted on this trail.
